REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION THROUGH THE UPPER YEAR OPTION (NUBSNU)

Upper Year Applicants must present the following high school courses (or out-of-province/post-secondary equivalent), for admission to the program. GED is not accepted in lieu of Grade 12:

- English Language Arts A30 (or French substitution)
- English Language Arts B30 (or French substitution)
- One of Foundations of Math 30 or Pre-calculus 30
- Biology 30
- Chemistry 30

A minimum of 65% UGPA on all post-secondary courses completed.

Upper Year Applicants must submit a Program Reference Form directly from each previous institution that a Nursing program was attended.

Upper Year Applicants other than Saskatchewan Polytechnic LPN/RPN or NorQuest LPN graduates must submit course outlines (syllabus) for all nursing courses that have been completed.

LPN and RPN Applicants must submit Proof of Current Practicing Licensure with their application.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE AFTER DEGREE NURSING PROGRAM (NUBSNUAD)

After Degree Program Applicants must have completed an approved undergraduate degree and have a minimum 70% UGPA on all post-secondary courses completed.

Applicant must show completion of the following courses:

- Human Anatomy and Physiology (with a minimum grade of 60%) - 6 credit hours (or equivalent; go to <http://www.sasknursingdegree.ca/wp-content/uploads/2017/09/Equivalency-List-for-Human-Anatomy-and-Physiology.pdf> for equivalent courses)
- English 100
- Statistics 100
- Indigenous Health Studies 100 or Indigenous Studies 100

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

By August 1, prior to the beginning of the first term, students admitted to the upper year or after degree program must submit following documents to reginaningdocuments@saskpolytech.ca:

- CPR BLS Health Care Provider (HCP) Certificate
- Standard First Aid Certificate
- Immunization Record
- Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) Training (dated within six [6] months of the start date of the program)
- Transferring, Lifting, Repositioning (TLR) Certificate
- Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check (CRC-VSC)
